**Level I, II, III (Beginner)** – Recommended for ages 5 & Up. Minimum 3 years & toilet trained. Beginner skills will be tested first day. **Level IV Advanced Beginner** - Must be able to jump into deep water and swim one length of pool. **Level V- (Intermediate)** – Build stroke work and endurance.
