

**CITY OF ST. CLAIR, MICHIGAN
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
MONDAY, JUNE 4, 2018 - 6:30 P.M.**

Mayor Cedar convened the Special Meeting of the City Council to order in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 547 N. Carney Drive, St. Clair, Michigan, at 6:30pm to discuss the M-29 Road Diet.

AUDIENCE: There were 6 people in attendance

M-29 Road Diet-City Superintendent Booth summarized the process thus far and explained there is no decision of one particular option at this point and MDOT will continue to accept opinions and suggestions to combine into a plan that best meets public's needs and wants. Discussion included the best start/end location for the road diet for both North and again South of the bridge, the possibility to move Cargill's entrance farther south and different scenarios to address the M-29/Clinton/Voyageur traffic concerns. MDOT did agree to look at the M-29/Clinton/Voyageur intersection to address the timing of the light and to possibly change the lanes from 4 down to 2 with a turning lane to alleviate stale traffic near the bridge. Trice Hawkins, Recreation Director, suggested to have the bike path connect the Bridge to Bay Trail and/or US20. MDOT has not yet provided their final option. Public comment included concern about bicyclist safety.
