

**CITY OF ST. CLAIR, MICHIGAN
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
MONDAY, TUESDAY, OCTOBER 22, 2018 - 7:00 P.M.**

Mayor Cedar convened the Special Meeting of the City Council in the Municipal Building, 547 N. Carney Drive, St. Clair, Michigan, at 7:00pm to conduct a hearing as required per Chapter 18, Article II, Section 18-32(b) of the St. Clair City Code of Ordinances.

AUDIENCE: There were 60 people in attendance

Hearing between City Council and Evan Rood, business owner-Mayor Cedar opened the hearing at 7:06pm. Mayor Cedar read aloud verbatim a letter from Mr. Roods attorney that stated, in part, the "two deficiencies upon which the suspension are based are acknowledged by Mr. Rood. The barber pole attached to the building will be covered immediately, and removed at the earliest opportunity. He will be in compliance with the Section 5.25 occupant restrictions at the earliest possible time." Mr. Rood nor his attorney were present. Councilmember Klieman questioned the timeline. City Council has 10 days from the date of the hearing to reinstate or revoke the license. No other comments from city council.

Kindsvater moved, Ellery seconded, CARRIED, to revoke the license.
