**Resolution of Authorization-Local Unit of Government Match
Michigan Department of Natural Resources Trust Fund Grant**

WHEREAS, the City of St. Clair supports the submission of an application titled, "Klecha Park Improvements" to the Michigan Department of Natural Resources Trust Fund Grant for development of an accessible playground, pavilion and parking at Klecha Park, and,

WHEREAS, the proposed application is supported by the Community's 5-Year Approved Parks and Recreation Plan; and,

WHEREAS, City of St. Clair is hereby making a financial commitment to the project in the amount of \$88,500.00 matching funds, in cash and/or force account; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of St. Clair hereby authorizes submission of a Michigan Department of Natural Resources Trust Fund Grant Application for \$206,300.00, and further resolves to make available a local match through financial commitment and donation(s) of \$88,500.00 (30%) of a total \$294,800.00 project cost, during the 2020-2021 fiscal year.
