4. Work completed by a government subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00.

Plans are required for all other building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to 1980 PA 299 and shall bear that architect's or engineer's seal and signature

Fixtures, floor drains, special drains, water closet, bath tub lavatories, shower shelf, laundry tray, urinal, autopsy sink, emergency eye wash, emergency shower, garbage grinder, water outlet cooler, ice making machine, water connected still, stop sink, bidet, cuspidor, dishwasher, refrigerator, water heater, drinking fountain, washing machine, acid waste drain, embalming table, bed pan washer, floor drain, roof drain, grease trap, starch trap, plaster trap, water softener, water outlet or connection to any make-up water tank, water outlet or connection to heating system, connection to sprinkler system (irrigation), water connected sterilizer, water connected to dental chair, water connected to carbonated beverage dispensers. Plus any other fixture, drain or water connected appliance not specifically listed. Domestic water treatment and filtering equipment: a license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed and the installation complies with the applicable codes. If the enforcing agency determined a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer, The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #25 for \$5.00 each and the appropriate water distribution pipe(system) size fee.

Instructions for completing application

General - Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the City of St. Clair. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Plumbing Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** The telephone number for the inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

Expiration of Permit - A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall be invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after the issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.

Where to submit Application - The Bureau of Construction Codes is responsible for code enforcement in units of government throughout the state which have no local program and for all state owned buildings. Permit applications for state issued permits should be sent to the address on the front of this application. If you are not sure whether a state permit or a local permit is appropriate, contact our office or your local building inspector.
