A RESOLUTION MODIFYING THE WATER AND SEWER TAP-IN FEES OF THE RIVERBANK THEATER, A MICHIGAN NON-PROFIT CORPORATION, FOR ITS THEATER DEVELOPMENT PROJECT FROM A TWO-INCH (2") LINE CHARGE TO A ONE-INCH (1") LINE CHARGE.

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of St. Clair adopted at a regular meeting of said Council held at City Hall located at 547 N. Carney Drive, St. Clair, Michigan, on the 4th day of April, 2022 at 7:00 PM.

WHEREAS, the Riverbank Theater is a Michigan Non-Profit Corporation organized under Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code; and,

WHEREAS, the Riverbank Theater is developing a theater project within the City that requires the payment of certain permit fees; and,

WHEREAS, the Riverbank Theater has asked the City for relief from the permit fees it must pay to complete its project, given its non-profit status; and,

WHEREAS, Section 3.9 of the Zoning Ordinance grants the City Council authority to determine and set the fees to be charged for all permits by resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the City Council of St. Clair, County of St. Clair, State of Michigan, to modify the tap-in fees paid by the Riverbank Theater for its project's connection to City water and sewer services from a two-inch (2") line charge to a one-inch (1") line charge.
