NOTICE OF PROJECT PLAN PUBLIC HEARING

The City of St. Clair will hold a public hearing for the purpose of receiving public comments and input regarding the proposed Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Project Plan. The public hearing will be held Monday, June 20, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 547 N. Carney Dr, St Clair, MI 48079.

The Project Plan focuses on improving reliability of the City's water treatment and distribution system to maintain water quality. The proposed projects include:

- Improvements at the water treatment plant and low service (Shorewell) pumping station to replace aging infrastructure and equipment
- Construction of 1,600 lineal feet of 12-inch water main to form a loop for system redundancy and to improve system pressure and fire flows

The estimated cost for the proposed improvements is \$10,933,000. The estimated quarterly user cost for a family of four to fund the proposed projects is \$77.45. User cost is discussed in further detail in Section 13.0 of the Project Plan.

The draft Project Plan will be available on the City's website from May 19, 2022 through June 20, 2022 for public viewing and comment. Comments can be emailed to Annette Sturdy at asturdy@cityofstclair.com. Comments received before June 20, 2022, will be considered part of the public record and included in the final Project Plan.
