**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE SUBMITTAL OF A MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF
NATURAL RESOURCES SPARK GRANT FOR THE INSTALLATION OF RESTROOM
FACILITIES AT GREIG PARK**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of St. Clair supports the submission of an application titled, "Greig Park Restroom Facilities" to the Spark grant program for installation of a new restroom facility, 24 feet by 24 feet in size at Greig Park located on North Carney Drive and owned by the City of St. Clair, and,

WHEREAS, the City of St Clair is hereby making a financial commitment to the project in the amount of 20 percent of the total project cost estimated at \$98,420 in matching funds, in cash and/or force account; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of St Clair hereby authorizes submission of a Spark Application in the amount of \$492,090.00, and further resolves to make available its financial obligation amount of \$98,420 during the 2023 fiscal year.
