**A RESOLUTION TO TENTATIVELY AWARD  
A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of St. Clair wishes to construct improvements to its existing water treatment (Water Treatment Plant) and distribution system (Water Main); and

**WHEREAS**, the water system improvements project formally adopted on June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022 will be funded through the state of Michigan's Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of St. Clair has sought and received construction bids for the proposed Water Treatment Plant and water main project and has received a low bid in the amount of \$19,789,000 from Weiss Construction Co. LLC.; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of St. Clair has reviewed the bid price and negotiated a modified project scope reduction in the amount of \$17,039,000 with Weiss Construction Co. LLC.; and

**WHEREAS**, the engineer, Fishbeck has recommended awarding the contract to the low bidder.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of St. Clair tentatively awards the contract for construction of the proposed Water Treatment Plant and Water Main project in the negotiated amount of \$17,039,000 to Weiss Construction Co. LLC, contingent upon successful financial arrangements with the DWSRF.
